# -Coach Dave Daubenmire

Dave Daubenmire, a veteran 25-year high school football coach, was spurred to action when he was sued by the ACLU in the late 1990's for allegedly mixing prayer with his coaching. After a two-year battle for his 1st amendment rights and a determination not to back down, the ACLU relented and offered coach an out of court settlement. God honored his stand and the ACLU backed off.

As a result of the experience, Coach Dave heard the call to move out of coaching a high school team, to the job of coaching God's team. A nonprofit ministry called Pass the Salt was formed and the Coach set out to encourage and motivate the Body of Christ to step into the cultural war. Not long after, in 1999 a Saturday talk radio program was born, broadcasting all over the state of Ohio from Columbus on AM 880 WRFD.

### The Minutemen

In the spring of 2002, Coach Dave was encouraged to help form an organization that would support others and take the lead on critical cultural issues. A few months later, over 50 men gathered together for a weekend boot camp and Minutemen United was born.

Since that time the Minutemen have been involved in numerous battles which include successfully lobbying a regional grocery store to remove "entry-level porn" magazines from their shelves, defending a local Pastor from a zoning board that was trying to prevent him from distributing food to millions of the poor across the country and aiding a local Columbus community in ousting a homosexual bathhouse from their neighborhood.

The Minutemen were there to protest the removal of the <u>Ten</u> <u>Commandments</u> in Adams County, Ohio and traveled to Montgomery Alabama to stand along side <u>Judge Roy Moore</u>
